## 4. SAR Training Provider

This paper advises that NZSAR is going to market for a SAR training provider for the multi-agency SAR training course suite. NZSAR is required to comply with the All of Government procurement process. NZSAR will seek tenders for an administrator or provider of these courses on the New Zealand Government Electronic Tenders Service (GETS). The proposals will be evaluated using an objective set of criteria.

The proposed timeline was outlined:

The total value of contract is \$440,000 annually and will be for three years.

There is an annual contract with Tai Poutini Polytechnic (TPP) but NZSAR are seeking a longer-term relationship. Presently, the contract is run year by year. TPP have been advised and will put forward a proposal.
