Notes:

- 1 A 'Large' event for SMS purposes is any SAROP, SAREX or Local Group training event that lasts for more than 4 hours and involves more than one team
- ₂ If, during an urgent initial response, time or resources (e.g. availability of forms) do not allow a Team Tasking and Safety Assessment Form to be completed prior to deployment, a Take Five Field Safety Check can be used instead
- ³ Take Five Field Safety Checks do not need to be carried out immediately upon deployment if a Team Tasking and Safety Assessment Form and team briefing have just been prepared and delivered. Take Five Field Safety Checks should be undertaken at appropriate intervals during all activities and whenever circumstances or conditions change significantly from those that existed at the start of the activity/task
